3. Entry deadline

For all competitions, **online** registration is open from the date indicated on the website and will close 30 minutes before the competition.

Entries after 10 October 2025 (23:59) are subject to a surcharge of CHF 5.- (except entries for the "Kids Run" and born in 2012 and younger for the "10 km Walking & Nordic Walking"). Registrations after 5 October 2025 (23:59) do not entitle you to a personalised bib with your name.

On-site registration in the race village is possible on Saturday 11 October 2025 from 14:00 until 30 minutes before the competition for Saturday's races and until 19:00 for the following day's races. On Sunday 12 October 2025 registration is open from 7:00 until 30 minutes before the race. On-site registration while bibs last.

The organiser may set a limit on the number of participants. If this occurs, registrations received later cannot be taken into account. Entries will be registered after receipt of payment.

The organiser reserves the right to disqualify participants at any time and without refund of the amount paid, if they have provided false information on personal data at the time of registration.

The organiser reserves the right, at its sole discretion, to refuse or revoke the registration of any athlete who, at past or present events, has behaved in a manner deemed not in accordance with the principles of fairness, sportsmanship, or which has been deemed detrimental to the image of the event, the welfare of other participants, the public or the organisation's staff. This decision may be taken at any time and without any obligation to provide specific reasons.



4. Registration and method of payment

Online: via www.ascona-locarno-run.ch with link on Datasport and following the instructions given for online registration. Various payment methods are available: credit card, Postcard, bank transfer, PayPal, etc.

On site: registration in the race village by cash payment only.

The entry fee already paid will not be refunded under any circumstances.

The organiser is not liable for any false information or data. At its own discretion, the organiser may decide to exclude the participant from the event without refunding the amount (including if it is suspected that the participant will take unauthorised substances before departure).

5. Services included in the entry fee:

9. Doping Controls

Doping controls may be carried out at any time. The current Swiss Olympic doping regulations apply to these competitions. By taking part, the runners submit to Swiss Olympic's anti-doping regulations and acknowledge the exclusive jurisdiction of Swiss Olympic's Disciplinary Committee for Doping Cases and the Court of Arbitration for Sport (TAS) in Lausanne, to the exclusion of the ordinary courts (see www.antidoping.ch).

10. Starting times

Participants are requested to arrive at the start at least 10 minutes before the start of their race.

11. Time limits

The event will take place according to the regulations of the Swiss Athletics Association. The organiser reserves the right to make exceptions.

13. Timekeeping

Timing service with disposable microchip from Datasport, integrated in the bib. The start number must be open, clearly visible at the front and worn on the chest. Passage times will be recorded and reported in the classifications.

14. Classifications

The rankings will be continually updated during the event; they can be consulted online on our website www.ascona-locarno-run.ch.

15. Prizes and award ceremonies

15.1 "Kids Run": All participants will be awarded a medal at the finish of each race. Prizes not collected will remain the property of the organiser.



15.2 "5 km Sunset Run": Prizes will be awarded to the first three overall male and female participants. Prizes not collected will remain the property of the organiser. Prize-giving ceremony on 11 October 2025 at 19:30.

15.3 "21 km Half Marathon": Prizes will be awarded to the first three of each category according to the categories indicated in point 7 of these regulations. Prizes will also be awarded to the first three overall male and female finishers of the "21 km Half Marathon". Prizes not collected will remain the property of the organiser.

Prize-giving ceremony on 12 October 2025 at 12:45.

15.4 "10 km Walking & Nordic Walking": Prizes will be awarded to the first three overall male and female finishers (who reach the finish line without the aid of scooters, bicycles or other auxiliary systems). Prize-giving ceremony at 1.30 p.m.

15.5 "10 km Run": Prizes will be awarded to the first three of each category according to the categories indicated in point 7 of these regulations. Prizes will also be awarded to the first three overall male and female finishers. Prizes not collected will remain the property of the organiser. Prize-giving ceremony on 12 October 2025 at 14.00.

Swiss Athletics awards ceremony on 12 October from 12.45. Special prize-giving ceremony on 12 October from 14.30 onwards.

16. Insurance

To be borne by the participants. The organisation declines all responsibility in case of injury, accident, damage or theft.

17. Changing rooms / showers / locker

Changing rooms and showers are located near the PalExpo in Locarno (at the SPAI Peschiera gymnasium, via alla Peschiera, Locarno) and are duly indicated.

Toilets are available in the start area and on the course.

A locker is available in the start area where you can leave your belongings for CHF 2.-. The organisers cannot be held responsible for the loss, theft or damage of items deposited in the cloakroom or left unattended elsewhere.

18. Validity

The event "Ascona-Locarno Run 2025" is organised according to the guidelines of the Swiss Athletics Federation, www.swiss-athletics.ch .

No medical certificate or membership of the federation is required to take part in the "Ascona-Locarno Run 2025"; however, by registering, each participant confirms "that they are in good physical health, that they are fit to take part in the race and that they have medical confirmation of this". The responsibility of the organisers of the "Ascona-Locarno Run" is in any case excluded.

The "21 km Half Marathon" is valid for the Swiss Half Marathon Championships 2025.

The "21 km Half Marathon" is valid for the Ticino Road Championship.

The "10 km Run" is valid for the **Ticino Road Championship**.

The course of the "21 km Half Marathon" is **approved** by Swiss Athletics. The route has international homologation.

The course of the "10 km Run" is approved by Swiss Athletics.



19. Swiss Runners Ticket

The free Swiss Runners Ticket for participants registered for competitions.

All participants benefit from a free journey with public transport in 2nd class, within Switzerland, from their place of residence/departure to the venue and back (on the usual routes in GA zones). After registering, runners will receive a document via e-mail or post with two personal promotional codes. Use these promotional codes to print a free 2nd-class public transport ticket for your outward journey and one for your return trip at www.sbb.ch/en/swissrunners (tickets each valid for 1 calendar day).

The outward journey can take place between 3 and 12 October 2025 and the return journey between 11 and 20 October 2025.

Important: The Swiss Runners Ticket is person-specific and only valid on the return journey together with the start number (bib number). Both must be shown together during ticket inspection.

Please note that you must show your ticket and bib number if you are checked on the means of transport. Further information can be found at www.sbb.ch/en/ascona-locarno-run (available from August).

Public transport throughout Switzerland is only guaranteed under the conditions listed above. The organisation excludes all liability, for example in case the participant does not respect the abovementioned conditions (e.g. if the participant omits to print out the ticket, travels wrongly in 1st class, travels outside the days listed above) or other rules (e.g. no smoking, etc.), or for damage to property or persons during travel.

20. Animals

Animals are not admitted to the competitions of the Ascona-Locarno Run.

21. Data protection

With the following directives, each participant:

- authorises the organisers of the "Ascona-Locarno Run" to use and/or publish and/or print all their photos and/or images directly related to the event;
- authorises the event organisers to pass on their personal details to the official photographer of the event. Each competitor may expressly refuse this data transmission by sending a request (registered letter) to the organisers;
- also authorises the publication by the organisers and/or their partners of the official results in printed or digital form.

In detail

21.1 Data protection declaration

The following provisions apply in the field of the use of your personal data during the "Ascona-Locarno Run".

21.2 What data do we process?

In order for your event registration to be valid, you must fill in each field of the form marked with an * correctly. In addition to yourself, you can also register other people. In this case we consider that you are authorised to register these third parties. If underage runners are registered by third parties, the organiser assumes that the consent of the legal representatives has been obtained. In the case of online registration, your e-mail address is obligatory for the confirmation of your registration and for any additional questions we may have. Furthermore, providing your mobile phone number and e-mail address will enable you to receive information about the event as soon as possible.



The use of personal data is governed by the data protection declaration (www.ascona-locarno-run.ch/data-protection). The runner undertakes to make the personal data of third parties available to the organiser only if they or their legal representatives are familiar with the applicable data protection declaration and are authorised to do so in accordance with the applicable data protection law. The organiser may at any time require the participant to prove the existence of these conditions - in particular the consent of third parties - within a specified period and may otherwise withdraw from all contracts without further ado.

21.3 Handling of your personal data

We use the services of an external specialist company to ensure the success of the event and to store and manage your data digitally. This company processes your personal data on our behalf and in confidence.

The companies that work for us for the organisation and execution of events, the processing of registrations (online, offline), the management of participant data, the recording of times, the compilation of results, the processing of starting numbers, the recruitment of participants and the processing of information and data, work on our behalf and solely for our purposes. In accordance with the law, we are obliged to monitor the data processing by these companies and to oblige them not to process the data for their own purposes or to pass it on to third parties.

Depending on the timing company, all runners must open an account with this company. The data protection declarations and general terms and conditions of the respective company (Datasport AG https://www.datasport.com) shall apply to the processing of accounting data.

21.4 Authorisation to process data

With your registration, you authorise the organisers to publish your first name, surname, date of birth, place of residence, bib number, race time and race rank. This authorisation is valid for publication on the internet as well as in the various media (newspapers, television, teletext and announcements made by the race announcer).

Films and photos taken during the event may be used on television, on the internet, in our advertising channels, in magazines and books without any right of compensation on the part of the individual competitor.

22. Photographs

By registering, the participant (and, if he is a minor, his legal representative) expressly authorises the organisation to take, or have taken by third parties on his behalf, and publish photographs and videos showing him (including close-ups). In particular, the publication and reproduction by the organisation and its partners and sponsors on any medium (internet, social media, media, newspaper, television, magazines, books, billboards, flyers, etc.) for informative, documentary, promotional and/or advertising purposes is authorised. The participant understands and accepts that photographs and videos depicting him/her may be disseminated worldwide.

The participant is not entitled to any compensation or remuneration for the photographs or videos of him/her.

In the event that a participant withdraws consent, he or she shall be obliged to compensate for any damage resulting from such withdrawal (e.g. costs of already printed advertising material, costs of removal and replacement of images, ...). The participant shall, however, be aware that images that have already been published in print media may no longer be retrieved and that images published on the Internet are quickly copied, shared and saved on multiple media, where they may no longer be deleted.



23. Cancellation of the event

In the case that the organisation has to cancel the event:

- due to force majeure (e.g. natural disasters, including flooding);
- due to unrest, war events, terrorist attacks, or
- if an authority (municipal, cantonal or federal) prohibits the event (for reasons of public order and/or health), or
- for other serious reasons (including the reasons listed above, should the organisers decide, contrary to the authorities, to cancel the event);

registration fees will not be refunded or recognised the following year. Any reimbursement of other expenses incurred in connection with the competition (e.g., accommodation, travel, absence from work) is also excluded. The organisation's insurer will not reimburse any amount to participants.

Participants are free to take out insurance cover.

24. Exemption from liability

The participant, by registering and consequently accepting these regulations, declares that he/she assumes all risks and damages resulting from participation in the races (e.g. health, injuries, falls, contacts/collisions with vehicles, with other participants, volunteers, spectators and others, phenomena related to weather conditions, road surface, etc.). He therefore expressly exempts the organiser and the individuals and partners involved in organising the sporting event from any liability for any damage arising from participation in the events.

The organiser declines all liability towards spectators and third parties.

25. Changes to the regulations

The organisers reserve the right to modify these regulations at any time for reasons they deem appropriate for the better organisation of the race. Any changes will be communicated to the participants or published on the website www.ascona-locarno-run.ch.

26. Validity of the regulations

In the event that one or more clauses of these regulations are invalid, ineffective or contrary to the law, the validity, legality and effectiveness of the remaining clauses will not be affected or compromised in any way, provided that the remaining clauses do not substantially alter the relationship between the parties.

27. Law and jurisdiction

These regulations and the contract between the parties shall be governed by Swiss law, and any dispute arising between the parties in relation to them shall be subject to the jurisdiction of the Locarno-Campagna court.

For the purposes of dispute resolution or in the event of problems of interpretation or differences between language versions, the Italian version shall prevail.

The organiser of the event is the Ascona-Locarno Run Association.
